As a reminder, Mount Mary's non-smoking policy states, "All buildings on campus are smoke-free. Smoking is not permitted less than 45 feet away from any building, with the exception of certain designated areas. Those areas are: the concrete aprons on either side of the front doors of Haggerty Library; the concrete table and benches outside the southeast door of Notre Dame Hall; the sidewalk leading to the woods at the northeast door of Notre Dame Hall; the west exit of Kostka Hall at the parking lot; and the linden arches of Bergstrom Hall, east of the exit at the Post Office." http://www.mtmary.edu/pdfs/resources/firesafety.pdf
